CRITERIA:

- Must be a U.S. citizen or have permanent status
- Must reside in one of the 23 counties designated in the Tennessee Valley WIRED region
- Must complete the Participant Form as required by the U.S. Department of Labor and the Intake Form indicating county of resident
- Must designate one of the STEM disciplines (see above) as the major Program of Study
- Must be enrolled and maintain full-time status throughout the semester during which the scholarship is awarded (minimum of 12 hours)
- Scholarships may be full or partial and may be used for tuition, fees and books
- Students receiving college credit must have a minimum 3.0 high school GPA or 2.75 for existing college coursework
